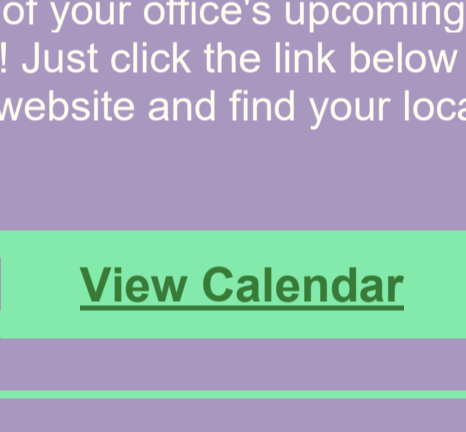

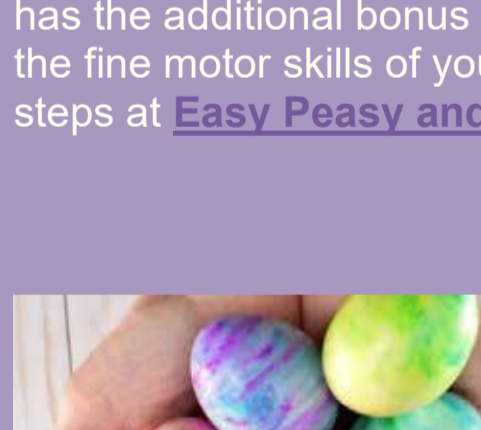
Salt Dough Easter Eggs
